

Suggested names for the two new open spaces need to comply with Geographic Names Victoria's [*Naming rules for places in Victoria*](#).

The principles and rules that apply to naming the two new open spaces are summarised below:

- Names should have a link to place and be relevant to the local area to ensure the preservation of our cultural heritage.
- Names can commemorate an event, person or place.
- The use of Traditional Owner languages is encouraged, and is subject to agreement from the relevant Traditional Owner group(s)
- The feature type should be included in a feature's name and located after the unique feature name. ie: XXXX Park/Reserve/etc
- Names must not duplicate another name within a 5 kilometre radius
- Names must not discriminate or cause offense.
- Names must be easy to pronounce, spell and write, and not exceed three words (including feature or road type) and/or 25 characters.
- Cardinal directions (north, south, east and west) must be avoided.
